

Executive Summary

Mississippi State Energy Efficient Appliance Rebate Program

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) allocated \$2.8 million to Mississippi to administer the State Energy Efficient Appliance Rebate Program (SEEARP), a residential rebate program designed to encourage the purchase of energy-efficient appliances. SEEARP will launch on Earth Day, April 22, 2010.

Utility companies and retailers have joined the Mississippi Development Authority in promoting this program statewide, encouraging Mississippians to replace existing, energy-inefficient appliances with new models. By promoting the replacement of old appliances, the rebate program will both stimulate the economy and reduce energy use and energy costs for consumers.
